

CROSS SECTIONS OF PATIO DOORS




OPTION B

OPTION C


When both door panels are moveable but only one of the panels are screened. The bug sweep allows both panels To open. The height measurement is the same as OPTION A





Option D, Both door panels are operable




1 x 2 rectangular aluminum tube is self supported at the top and bottom with angle clips, the tube is not attached to the patio door panel


TOP VIEWS OF 3 AND 4 PANEL PATIO DOORS








FOR EITHER SINGLE OR DOUBLE DOORS






FACE MOUNTING DIAGRAM

FACE MOUNT (on the face of the door frame) CROSS SECTION


